PROGRAM SYNOPSIS

Mathematics Development and Enrichment Program is an academic support program for learners who require support and exposure in strengthening core concepts in mathematics. There is a specific focus on arithmetic and problem-solving. The program entails a mixture of computer-based, group- and peer-assessed activities, games, problem-solving, lateral thinking and mathematical challenges.

The focus of such a development program is to strengthen core concepts with a particular focus on mastery of concepts. In addition, the benefits of this program are primarily long-term and may/may not easily translate into immediate report card scores. The aim of the program is to invest in the learner's intellectual ability, develop a deeper appreciation for the applications of mathematics, and help to better prepare students for high school.

The sessions are held twice-weekly. One sessions focusses on the essential curriculum described above, while the other session is aligned to the school-based curriculum (CAPS).

PROGRAM COSTS

BASIC PROGRAM STRUCTURE

- 10-months
- Approximately 70 sessions per year
- Twice weekly

FEE STRUCTURE

Reg fee: R425 for new students and R325 for returning students (includes required textbook)

Tuition fees:

DEBIT ORDER/EARLY EFT: 10 monthly installments of R500 payable in advance from February to November (For Programs starting in Feb).

OR

EFT: 6 monthly installments of R891 payable in advance from February to July (For Programs starting in Feb).

OR

EFT: 4 quarterly installments of R1400 payable in advance each quarter (For Programs starting in Feb).
