Program: YaleSA Matric Repeat Candidate Program for Mathematics and/or Physical Science in 2016

PROGRAM SYNOPSIS

The program consists of a combination of online lessons and tuition sessions at our support centre. Students are provided with the opportunity to learn these lessons online, and receive support, intervention and academic instruction at our centre three days a week.

The syllabus covers the entire grade 12 syllabi for mathematics and physical sciences with over 800 exam practice questions, thousands of online generated activities, and mock exam periods. The course allows students to redo their school-based-assessment tasks (SBA) and rewrite their final examinations.

Upon successful completion, an application for a combined statement of results and amended National Senior Certificate will be facilitated by our centre. Students may use their updated marks for applying to tertiary studies.

ACCREDITATION

YaleSA is a registered assessment and examination centre for the South African Comprehensive Assessment Institute (SACAI). SACAI is an independent examination body like that of the IEB, and is accredited by Umalusi to administer the National Senior Certificate examinations for private candidates and independent schools. Students will be issued a new statement of results for the upgraded subjects. Students may also apply for a combined matric certificate by Umalusi.

PROGRAM COSTS

BASIC STRUCTURE

- Three sessions per week in the mornings - Tentative start date: early March
- 08h30 - 11h15 (maths & physics or half time for 1 subject)
- Redo CASS/SBA

- Four sessions per week during the evening - Tentative start date: late-February
- 18:30 - 20:15 (two maths & two physics)
- Redo CASS/SBA

FOR TWO (2) SUBJECTS

Reg fee: R1000

Exam fee: R1950

Monthly install: R9000 (R1000 per month for 9 months - March till November)

TOTAL COST: 11 950

FOR ONLY ONE (1) SUBJECT

Reg fee: R1000

Exam fee: R1150

Monthly install: R5040 (R560 per month for 9 months - March till November)

TOTAL COST: 7 190

* Laptop fee: R75/month (only if student doesn't have own laptop/tablet/device) etc.

Payment structure:

Reg fee can be paid 65% on registration and balance following month

Monthly tuition fee to be paid at start of each month

Exam fee: (65% to be paid at reg. and the remainder the following month, in full by 1 April 2016)

Classes will take place at 332 Imam Haron Road, Lansdowne.

- * The examination fee per subject is paid on behalf of the student to the examination body. This is a per-subject fee and is payable in two parts during the year.
- ** The student laptop fee is only required if the students do not have their own device (laptop or suitable tablet) to use at our centre.
